


Twill Blocks on Four Shafts

On four shafts, we can weave two blocks by sharing two shafts in the threading, forming a right-



handed and a lefthanded three-shaft twills, as shown in the drawdown on the left. There are different ways of treadling the blocks; two are shown here, the second resulting in a 1 / 2 straight twill in each block. The fabrics for the two options are





below.
